RE: Our pets need your help. Please amend the Animals for Research Act to stop researchers taking our lost pet cats and dogs

Ontario is one of Canada's largest users of pet dogs and cats in experimentation and you have the power to protect them from a life of pain, suffering and death at the hands of the researchers.

Over 5,000 of our lost pet cats and dogs are taken by researchers each year according to government statistics. Under the Animals for Research Act, it's the law.
